Adding Publications to the Research Results Portal

There are three ways publications end up on the NASA Earth Science Research Results Portal:

1. CMS Monthly Telecon Presentations: When PIs present their publications during the monthly telecons, CMS Support will submit these quad charts to the CMS site and to Megan McGroddy, who then adds them to the portal.
2. Submitting publications to the CMS Site: When PIs manually submit new publications to the [CMS site](#), CMS support will send these new entries monthly to Megan McGroddy.
3. Adding publications directly to the portal: **PIs are strongly encouraged to submit publications directly to the portal themselves.** An account must be requested. The Earth Science Research Results Portal is found at: <https://esdresearch.nasa.gov>
